2010 AHM Golf Open**

The Board of Directors for AHM Youth and Family Services has recently announced plans for its **SEVENTH ANNUAL AHM GOLF OPEN** to benefit the children and families of Andover, Hebron, Columbia and Marlborough Connecticut. A committee of local business men and women and residents have joined together to organize the tournament again this year. The committee is planning a great day for the 2010 AHM Golf Open featuring a round of golf, a chance to win numerous prizes and contests, a luncheon, and awards ceremony.

The goal is to raise \$11,000.00 for AHM Youth and Family Services. All of the net proceeds from this event will go directly back to the youth services bureau so that AHM can continue offering a wide range of services for local children and their families. The event is the youth service bureaus first major fundraiser of each new fiscal year and plays a major role in funding a number of programs between July and December 2010.

AHM is a regional youth services bureau that provides a wide range of programs for Andover, Columbia, Hebron, and Marlborough residents. Some of the programs supported by the golf tournament include: juvenile review board, family counseling services, lanterns mentoring program, adult grief support network, summer youth theater, and teen center.

The tournament will be held at Blackledge Country Club on Monday July 12, 2010, beginning at 9:00 AM. The tournament is scheduled for a "shotgun" start at 9:30 AM. An afternoon picnic will be hosted by the Armata Family from Ted's Supermarket.

The cost to play in the tournament this year is \$125.00 for individuals, with an added incentive again this year of a \$100.00 discount for all pre-registered foursomes, (\$400.00). For those that do not play golf but would like to serve as a sponsor to show support for AHM can do so as well. There are multiple ranges for serving as a sponsor. Sponsoring the tournament is a great way to publicize local businesses with more than 100 players expected to attend the event.
